



# SIMPLE GARDENING AT HOME

## **A Pallet Garden**

A pallet garden can be designed and take you as far as your imagination will go. I have seen them put together as A-frames, and many other combinations. Lettuce, strawberries, peas, herbs and many flowers grow well, and they can be above the ground to keep the wildlife out! All but root vegetables should do well in a pallet garden.

### MATERIALS:

- A pallet or pallets in good condition, preferably made from untreated wood
- Staple gun with staples
- Garden fabric or landscaping fabric, burlap if available, could add some nice design and texture
- Potting mix
- Plants

### Procedure:

1. Take the pallet and cover the back and sides with the fabric, the purpose is to keep the soil in place.
2. Staple fabric to the pallet.
3. Fill the spaces from the top and front with the potting soil.
4. Plant and water.
