

SIMPLE CRAFTING:

"Better Than Salt Dough"
Baking Soda/Corn Starch
Ornaments

Make porcelain white ornaments with three simple ingredients.

Ingredients:

½ cup cornstarch

1 cup baking soda

34 cup water

Other:

Cookie cutters

Rolling pin (embossed will make nice textures)

Food coloring if you like

Paint, markers

Procedure:

- **1.** Combine baking soda, cornstarch and water in a medium sized pot.
- **2.** Stir over medium heat until mixture resembles mashed potatoes.
- **3.** Remove from heat, spoon the ball of dough into a ball and cover with a damp towel.
- 4. When its cool, knead it until silky and smooth.
- **5.** Preheat oven to 175 degrees F.
- **6.** Roll the dough about 1/4" thick.
- 7. Use cookie cutters to make shapes you desire.
- 8. Transfer to a cookie sheet.

- **9.** Use a pencil or chopstick to make a hole at the top to string ribbon for hanging later.
- **10.** Place in the oven for about 1 hour, turning over about 30 minutes.
- **11.** Decorate or paint with markers, paint, etc.
- 12. String with ribbon for hanging.
